1. Letter Identification and corresponding sound cards
2. Proper letter formation as found on the attachment on the Parent Resources page
3. Phonogram cards
4. Beginning of the year wall words along with weekly word list that will be added to the word wall throughout the school year
5. First grade sight vocabulary words
6. 20 leveled reader bins filled with hundreds of books
7. 75 Open Court Reading leveled books with multiple copies for small group reading and discussion
8. Personal journals and sentence strips to help connect their reading to their writing



### **Online Resources used in Title 1 for 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Students**

1. Reading Eggs is an online reading site. This site makes learning to read interesting and engaging to emerging readers with hundreds of individually structured activities and lessons.
2. Raz Kids is an online site that also engages young readers with developmentally leveled books at 27 reading levels to increase comprehension and fluency. These leveled readers can be done with or without sound. Comprehension questions are also available.
3. TumbleBooks – eBooks for eKids! The Tumble Book Library is an online collection of animated, talking picture books which teach young children the joys of reading. Like the Raz Kids site, these books can also be done without sound and have comprehension questions available for each story.

I will also be using a variety of other materials and resources as individual instruction warrants it. These would include but are not limited to:

- Scholastic Readers
- Basic Picture Words (flash cards)
- 3 Letter Words (Puzzle Cards)
- Magnetic Letters and Trays
- The “Big Books”
