1. Literative is the acknowledged leader in early learning online. They provide a vast amount of resources, lessons, and reading material for kindergarten students.
2. Reading Eggs is an online reading site. This site makes learning to read interesting and engaging to emerging readers with hundreds of individually structured activities and lessons.
3. Raz Kids is an online site that also engages young readers with developmentally leveled books to increase comprehension and fluency. These leveled readers can be done with or without sound. Comprehension questions are also available.
