# Goal #1: 2015-2016 All School

#### **Student Achievement Goal:**

Improve student reading scores on the Minnesota Comprehensive Assessments to surpass the state average score at all levels.

#### Staff Development Goal:

Improve reading and writing strategies for all teachers that can be implemented in all parts of the curriculum for all students. Elementary teachers will have monthly meetings to discuss reading and all teachers will participate in reading inservice days.

# Reasons for this Goal:

In the past years of the test, the 7<sup>th</sup> grade students achieved state average for the first time in 2007-2008 and has achieved state average or above only two other years in the ten years the test has been given. The 8<sup>th</sup> grade students have achieved state average twice out of the past eight years.

#### **Data Analyzed for Goal:**

Scores on the Minnesota Comprehensive Tests will be used to determine if the goal was met.

# **Evaluation Plan:**

Teachers will use classroom assessments to watch progress. The elementary students will also use the STAR reader test at least two times per year (fall and spring), NWEA tests for students in grades K-3, and Study Island computer program for students in grades 3-6 to provide additional assessment information for the teachers and students.

Elementary teachers will be meeting at least one time per month to discuss various reading and writing strategies. Administration and peer teachers will observe teachers in their reading curriculum to make suggestions for improvement.

# Goal #2: 2015-2016 All School

#### Student Achievement Goal:

Improve student learning through staff and student use of technology available in the school district.

# **Staff Development Goal:**

Staff will learn to use the various technologies available in the school district, along with the programs and accessories.

#### Reasons for this Goal:

Technology is becoming a bigger part of every student's life. Through technology, many students are more engaged in learning as they become more active participants in the process.

# **Data Analyzed for Goal:**

Through staff surveys, it was determined that staff were not effectively using the technologies available to them as lack of training and time available to learn were cited as barriers to more integration.

### **Evaluation Plan:**

Staff will be surveyed at the end of each year to determine the programs and technologies they are using and also the amount of time they are using them. Also, the amount of time the computer labs and laptop carts are used by staff members will be documented and recorded to determine if their usage has increased.

# Goal #3: 2015-2016 All School

#### **Student Achievement Goal:**

Improve student mathematics scores on the Minnesota Comprehensive Assessments to surpass the state average score at all levels.

# Staff Development Goal:

Improve math strategies for all teachers that can be implemented in all parts of the curriculum for all students.

# Reasons for this Goal:

Nevis Elementary School has been at or above state average in mathematics on 30 of the last 38 tests given. However, the one grade that is of concern in the elementary is 3<sup>rd</sup> grade as they have not achieved state average for five of the past seven years.

In Nevis High School, the students have achieved state average on only 9 of 29 tests. In the spring of 2012, all students were required to pass the 11<sup>th</sup> grade mathematics test to graduate from high school or take a remediation test and take it three times. This is a concern as Nevis School has been below state average the last seven of the nine years on the 11<sup>th</sup> grade mathematics test. The goal is for all students to pass the test and be able to graduate from high school.
